

## PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY POLICY

This Personal Data Privacy Policy (hereinafter – the Confidentiality Policy/Policy) has been developed in accordance with the requirements of Russia’s Federal Law No. 152-FL, dated July 27, 2006, «On Personal Data», as well as the requirements of Regulation No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union dated April 27, 2016 «On protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and free circulation of such data, including the repeal of Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR)». The Policy determines the procedure for processing personal data obtained by the Operator from the Website Users and Data Subjects when using the website <https://2022.atomexpo.ru/>, <https://atomexpo2022.accreditation.ru/> and their individual sections/pages (hereinafter referred to as the Website), and measures to ensure the security of personal data at Limited Liability Company «Sistemy registratsii i akkreditatsii» (TIN 7708278895, room 1/1/2, floor 1, b. 7, p. 2, Kolskaya st., Moscow, 129329, Russian Federation) (hereinafter referred to as the Operator) to protect human and civil rights and freedoms while processing personal data.

### 1. Terms and Definitions

#### 1.1. This Confidentiality Policy uses the following terms:

1.1.1. «Operator» – a state authority, municipal authority, legal or physical entity that independently or jointly with other entities organize and (or) perform the processing of personal data, as well as define the purposes of personal data processing, the composition of personal data to be processed, and the actions (transactions) performed with personal data;

1.1.2. ATOMEXPO International Forum is the main event of the global nuclear industry.

It is the largest exhibition and business platform for discussing the current state of the nuclear industry and setting future trends, and has been held annually since 2009.

The Forum is attended by executives from the key companies working in the global nuclear industry, government agencies, international and non-commercial organizations, and leading experts.

1.1.3. «Personal Data» – any information relating to a directly or indirectly identified or identifiable natural person (Data Subject);

1.1.4. «Processing of personal data» means any action (transaction) or a number of actions (transactions) performed with or without automated technologies in regards to such personal data, including collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, rectification (updating, changes), retrieval, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), depersonalization, blocking, deletion, and destruction of personal data;

1.1.5. «Confidentiality of personal data» – obligatory compliance by the Operator, User or another entity granted with access to personal data with the requirement of preventing its disclosure or dissemination without the consent of the User or any legal ground;

1.1.6. «Website <https://2022.atomexpo.ru/>» (the Website) – a collection of interconnected web pages, sections and subsections located on the Internet at the unique address (URL): <https://2022.atomexpo.ru/>;

1.1.7. «Website <https://atomexpo2022.accreditation.ru/>» (the Website) – a collection of interconnected web pages, sections and subsections located on the Internet at the unique address (URL): <https://atomexpo2022.accreditation.ru/>;

1.1.8. «Website User» (the User) – a person who uses the Website and has registered on the Website and/or possesses the access details for the Website (login and password);

1.1.9. «Cookie file» — is a small piece of data that a website requests from the browser used on your computer or mobile device. Cookies allow the website to «remember» your actions or preferences. Cookies are stored locally on your PC or mobile device. Users can delete saved cookie files if they wish;

1.1.10. «IP address» – a unique network address of the computer network host through which the User accesses the website.

1.1.11. «Personal data user» (User) – an individual whose data is transferred to the Operator for processing.

Any other terms and definitions used in this Confidentiality Policy that are not mentioned in this section will be interpreted systematically in connection with the other terms, individual conditions, and according to the meaning that follows from the text of the Policy. Where it is not possible to define the content of a term or concept from the text of the Policy, the definition of the term or concept in question shall be determined in accordance with the applicable law in force or in accordance with the prevailing law enforcement practice.

### 2. General Provisions

2.1. Usage of the Website by the User shall mean the User's consent to this Confidentiality Policy, and the terms and conditions of processing the User's personal data described herein.

2.2. In case of any disagreement with the terms of this Confidentiality Policy, the User should stop using the Website.

2.3. This Confidentiality Policy applies to the Website. The Operator does not control and is not responsible for the websites (and their content) of third parties to which the User can go using the links available on the website.

2.4. The Operator does not check and does not guarantee the authenticity of personal data provided by Users.

### 3. Processed Data

3.1. Categories of personal data to be processed may include the following:

- 3.1.1. Basic information about User - Full name in Russian and English, date of birth
- organization
  - position

- photo (type - “for documents”, color, on a white/light background)
- email
- phone number

3.1.2. Information about the User's actions on the Website, about the devices used by the User (including the IP address of the device), other information specified in cl. 3.2.

3.2. Use of cookies:

3.2.1. Cookies files, information about the User's actions on the Website, information about the User's equipment, date and time of the session are processed in order to ensure correct operation of the Website, convenience of its use by the User; information about the actions of the Website Users is also processed to determine the User's preferences while working with the Website and further improve the functionality of the Website.

3.2.2. The User may disable cookies, after doing so the User may find that some sections of the Website are not functioning properly.  
Instructions on managing cookies can usually be found in the help service (Help function) or settings of the browser.

4. Objectives, Grounds and Methods of Personal Data Processing

4.1. User personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

4.1.1. Identify the User, create an account for the User on the Website and provide the User with access to the content and functionality of the Website: in particular, to enable the User to register as a participant of the Event and other events (hereinafter – Other Events);

4.1.2. Identify the User as a participant of the Event and ensure the opportunity to provide the User with the services related to such events (in particular, creation and printing of badges, registration of passes, booking of venues where the events are held, and other similar actions necessary for the proper conduct of the events), as well as to allow the User to enter the event venues (in the case of offline formats);

4.1.3. Notify and provide the User with necessary information about the Event and Other Events (e.g., venue, dates, etc.), as well as sending information and news messages to the User;

4.2. User personal data is processed only if there is a legal basis for such processing, in particular, in cases where:

- the User has given consent to the processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes;

- the processing of personal data is necessary to allow the Operator to fulfill their contractual obligations to the User or to conclude an agreement with the User;
- their processing is necessary to allow the Operator to exercise their rights and legitimate interests or to promote the implementation of the rights and legitimate interests of third parties (including for the achievement of socially significant goals);
- their processing is necessary in order to fulfill the obligation imposed on the Operator by the applicable law;
- other legal basis provided by the applicable law.

4.3. Personal data can be processed both with the use of means of automation (automated processing), and without the use of such means (non-automated processing), and may include the following actions: collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, specification (updating, modification), retrieval, use, blocking, removal, destruction of personal data, depersonalization and also transfer (provision, granting of access) of data to other entities: "Center for Information and Exhibition Activities of the Nuclear Industry" (11 Ordzhonikidze str., Moscow, 115419, Russian Federation, p.40, fl.4, room I, com. 3, 4, 6, 7, 9-16, 21-25) (to provide technical assistance to achieve the goals indicated above).

4.4. The Operator shall provide recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, specification (updating, modification), retrieval of personal data of citizen of the Russian Federation using databases located on the territory of the Russian Federation.

### 5. Period of Personal Data Processing

5.1. User personal data is processed for as long as necessary to achieve the above purposes or observe the requirements of the applicable legislation.

5.2. Processing of personal data in order to send the User information and news messages on events held by the Operator of the ATOMEXPO International Forum, as well as in other cases where the processing of personal data is based on consent given by the User for the relevant purpose of processing, is carried out until withdrawal of consent by the User or until the expiration of such consent.

5.3. User personal data may be processed after the Event closure or deletion of the User account on the Website in cases provided for by applicable laws.

### 6. Rights and Obligations of the User and the Operator

6.1. The User may:

6.1.1. When registering on the Website, the User may give, of their own free will and volition, their consent to the processing of personal data, as well as withdraw their consent at any time by sending a request for withdrawal in free written form to the addresses specified in cl. 8.1.

6.1.2. Request a confirmation of their personal data processing. In case of such processing the User has a right to familiarize themselves with the personal data

being processed, as well as with information about the purposes of processing, the categories of data being processed, actions with the data, receivers of the data and guarantees for data transfer to third parties, the period of processing, the sources of the data, whether decision-making is fully automated, and whether the User is included in the Operator's mailing lists. The User may also request a list of processed personal data.

6.1.3. Request to modify their personal data if inaccuracies are found in the personal data processed by the Operator. Taking into account the purposes of data processing, the User may supplement the personal data, including by submitting an additional application.

6.1.4. The User may initiate limitations on processing all or some of their personal data if one of the following conditions is met:

- the accuracy of personal data is being contested by the User (limitation of the time necessary for the Operator to confirm the accuracy of the personal data);
- unlawful personal data processing has been revealed, and the User opposes deleting the personal data and instead demands limiting their use;
- Operator no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of processing, but the User needs them for substantiation, execution or controlling defense as part of a litigation;
- the User opposes the processing of their personal data (limitation of the time necessary for the Operator to confirm whether the Operator's legal grounds for personal data processing prevail over the lawful grounds of the User).

6.1.5. The User has a right to demand deletion of their personal data from the Website and/or other existing tangible media if one of the following conditions is met:

- the personal data is no longer required for the purposes for which they have been obtained;
- the User withdraws their consent on the basis of which the processing has been carried out, provided there are no other legal grounds for the processing;
- the personal data is being processed unlawfully;
- the personal data must be deleted to ensure compliance with a legal obligation in accordance with legislative requirements;

6.1.6. The User has a right to demand the list of their personal data provided to the Operator for the processing thereof in a structured, universal and machine-readable format, and to instruct the Operator to transfer their personal data to a

third party if the Operator has the technical possibility to do so. In this case the Operator shall not be responsible for further actions of a third party related to the personal data.

6.1.7. The User has a right to oppose processing of all or a part of the list of their personal data for the purposes indicated when the personal data was provided for the Operator, except for cases where the legal grounds for personal data processing prevail over the interests, rights and freedoms of the User or where the processing of the personal data is necessary for substantiation, performance or defense in legal proceedings.

6.1.8. The User has the right to bring a complaint to the supervisory authority responsible for protection of data subjects' rights, if the Operator violates their rights in any way in relation to personal data processing.

### 6.2. The User shall:

- 6.2.1. Take any and all necessary steps to ensure confidentiality of their account details (login and password) for accessing the User profile, and make sure that the password is not saved in the browser in case the User's device is used by other people.
- 6.2.2. Refrain from posting materials depicting other people or their personal data without a proper legal basis, unless such basis is not required by applicable law.
- 6.2.3. Provide only true and correct personal data that correspond to their identity documents.

### 6.3. The Operator shall:

- 6.3.1. Use the received personal data of Users only for the purposes specified in cl. 4 of this Confidentiality Policy.
- 6.3.2. Ensure the storage of User personal data in secret, not disclose it without the consent of the User, and not sell, exchange, publish or disclose in other possible ways the transferred personal data of the User, except for the transfer to authorized state authorities of the Russian Federation only on the grounds and in the manner established by the applicable laws.
- 6.3.3. Process the personal data of the User and ensure the confidentiality and protection of the processed personal data in accordance with Federal Law No. 152-FL, dated July 27, 2006, «On Personal Data», as well as the GDPR. When processing personal data, the Operator shall take necessary legal, organizational and technical steps to protect personal data received from the User against unauthorized or accidental access, destruction, modification, blocking, copying, provision, distribution, or other illegal actions with personal data received from the User.

### 7. Additional Terms and Conditions

7.1. The Operator may amend this Confidentiality Policy. The Operator recommends to regularly review the Confidentiality Policy.

7.2. This Confidentiality Policy shall come into effect upon its publication on the Website, unless otherwise provided for by a new version of the Confidentiality Policy.
